

October 1, 1998

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on October 1, 1998 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township building. Board members present were Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Baer & Goldie Day. Others present were: Timothy Steger, Sgt. Gerald Smith of the Pennsylvania State Police, Linda Cook, Kelly Mills, John Kovach & Robert Finke.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes of the September 9th meeting were approved as written.

Lt. Gerald Smith of the Pennsylvania State Police Barracks in Loganville gave an update of police services in the Township. He reported that crime is down in the County, also low in this area. He also said that drug dealing is not a problem in this area. It is hard to prosecute drug dealers unless you have positive proof. Most dealers in the area only sell to persons they know.

The supervisors had some questions of Lt. Smith as did Linda Cook, a resident. He told those present to call the barracks when they have a problem.

Timothy Steger gave the report of road work in September. He also feels that Bonnair Road would be a project to consider for 1999. Also, C.S. Davidson, Inc. has recommended that the metal barrels at Buffalo Valley Road be replaced with plastic barrels. The Board made no decision on this.

Daryl Jurkiewicz, engineer for C.S. Davidson, has looked at the Buffalo Valley Road Bridge and will prepare a cost estimate of repairs for this bridge. This engineering work will be \$1200.

Goldie Day made a motion to accept C.S. Davidson, Inc.'s proposal for the engineering work outlined in Mr. Jurkiewicz's letter at a cost of \$1,200. Brian Baer seconded this motion. The motion carried.

Brian Baer made a motion to issue a road occupancy permit to GTE for work on Water Tank Road, seconded by Goldie Day. This motion carried.

Goldie Day made a motion to accept the resignation of Sandra Hartlaub as tax collector, effective December 31, 1998, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.

The Board will need to have a CPA Audit of Sandra's records after the end of the year.

Brian Baer made a motion to appoint Kelly Mills as tax collector for 1999, seconded by Goldie Day. This motion carried.

If Ruth Baer, a former tax collector, helps Kelly with her work, the Board will see that she gets some compensation for time.

Brian Baer made a motion to appoint Frank Cluster as auditor for 1999 to replace Shirley Shamer who has moved from the Township. Lamar Glatfelter seconded this motion. Motion carried.

Both the above appointments are for one year only. If they wish to continue in these positions, they will need to be on the ballot in May to run for the two year term remaining for each.

The York County Association of Second Class Township Supervisors will hold the County Convention on November 5, 1998. This is the date of the regular meeting night.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to change the first meeting of the Board in November to the 4th (the first Wednesday) seconded by Brian Baer. This motion carried.


Supervisors, Auditors & Tax Collectors are eligible to attend this Convention.

The bills were presented to the Board. Brian Baer made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.
