The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on December 9, 1998 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township building. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Baer and Goldie Day. Others present were: Solicitor John Herrold, Marsha McKnight and Robert Finke.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

Under public comments, Marsha McKnight had a question regarding the workshop with Jefferson Borough Council members. Lamar Glatfelter told her that no decisions were made, only some information received.

The secretary had the 1999 budget ready for adoption. This proposed budget had been advertised as required for notifying the public that it was open for public inspection until this date.

There were no changes recommended from any Board member to the proposed budget as prepared by the Secretary.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to approve the 1999 budget as proposed, seconded by Brian Baer. This motion carried.

There are no tax increases for 1999.

Solicitor Herrold reported that there is a Tax Payers Bill of Rights that will have to be adopted. The State Association of Township Supervisors is asking that the Townships do nothing until the Association comes out with a draft.


