

January 13, 1999

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on January 13, 1999 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township building. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Baer and Goldie Day. Other present were Solicitor John Herrold, Timothy Steger and Robert Finke.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

There were no public comments.

Solicitor Herrold had Resolution #99-1 which establishes fees to be charged by the Sewage Enforcement Officer for services rendered by the Sewage Enforcement Officer.

Brian Baer made a motion to adopt Resolution #99-1, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. The motion carried.

Goldie Day made a motion to issue a junkyard renewal license to Virginia Snyder Tressler, seconded by Brian Baer. This motion carried.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to issue a road occupancy permit to GTE for work on Valley View Drive, seconded by Brian Baer. This motion carried.

Tim Steger gave the roadmaster report. The 1995 Ford Dump Truck which had damage to the snow plow frame in an accident by employee Darrell Henry is at Jones & Sipe. The truck frame is also bent and is being straightened by Jones & Sipe. The snow plow frame will be repaired or replaced by Lancaster Truck and will take a couple of weeks since parts have to be ordered.

Tim has talked to Manheim Township regarding the rebar for the Pentland Road bridge replacement. He thinks this will be a job that the Township employees will not be able to do. Tri-Boro Concrete in Dallastown knows a Company that could do this job.

Tom Leckrone of C.S. Davidson will be at the Township on Monday, January 18<sup>th</sup> to go over the bidding specs for the new bridge.

Tim also discussed the drainage problem at Messersmith & Tome Roads. They will probably have to dig up the pipes.



Solicitor Herrold has received some material from the State Association of Township Supervisors regarding the Tax Payer Bill of Rights and will be working on an ordinance for this.

The bills were presented to the Board. Brian Baer made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Goldie Day. This motion carried.
