

April 1, 1999

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on April 1, 1999. Board members present were Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Baer & Goldie Day. Others present were Timothy Steger, Kevin Burk, Kelly Mills, Charles Wheat, Robert Finke and John Kovach.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting to order with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was given to the Board members.

Under public comments, Charles Wheat wanted to know if Bill Davis needs a permit for the storage of junk at his property along Rt. 216.

Kevin Burk presented the 2-lot subdivision plan of his property along Hildebrand Road. The \$500.00 recreation fee was paid.

Goldie Day made a motion to approve the Kevin Burk subdivision plan seconded by Brain Baer. This motion carried and the plan was signed.

Patrick Buhl of Don Worley Surveying presented the Luetta Warner 2-lot subdivision plan. The PennDot Highway permit has not yet been issued since the sight must have more fill added. Mrs. Warner has signed the Driveway agreement. She cannot sell the lot until the State Highway permit has been obtained.

Brain Baer made a motion to approve the Luetta Warner subdivision plan subject to the driveway permit, seconded by Goldie Day. This motion carried and the plan was signed. The \$500.00 recreation fee has been paid.

Kelly Mills presented the March tax collection report. She will be taking the list of properties to be liened to the County on April 12<sup>th</sup>. Also, she will have some more paid 1998 per capita taxes to report to the Township before the delinquent list is mailed to Berkheimer Associates.

The Board received a breakdown of the hours Ruth Baer has spent working with the new tax collector, Kelly Mills. She has spent 16 hour helping Kelly.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to pay Ruth Baer \$250.00 for the above service, seconded by Goldie Day. Brain Baer recused himself from voting. The motion passed by majority vote.

Timothy Steger, Roadmaster, gave the roadmaster report for the month.

Tim has received three (3) quotations for a new radio communications system. The Board members want to review these quotes before making a decision.

Tim wanted to know if he had the Boards permission to begin working with Manheim Township on the work that the two Townships need to do before the contractor's work begins on the Pentland

bridge . He was told to go ahead with whatever work the two townships need to do.

The Board instructed the roadmaster to get quotations on liquid calcium chloride for this spring. Since the application of this chloride seemed to work well last Spring, the Board will seek quotes on 6,000 gals.

Tim also asked the Board about the employees doing some road straightening, etc. on Brenneman Road in the area of the Bloomfield property. He was told not to do anything on this road at present, since the residents living on Brenneman Road can use Krebs Road for getting to and from their properties.

The secretary reported that an employee has asked if the Board would approve the cost of lyme disease vaccinations. Since the employees work in tall weeds and brush, they have a chance of coming in contact with ticks.

The secretary has called Workfirst for information on this vaccine.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion that if the employee wants the series of vaccinations for lyme disease, the Board will pay for them, but the Board does not require the employee to get the vaccinations. Brian Baer seconded this motion. This motion carried.

The bills were presented to the Board. Brian Baer made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Galtfelter. This motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 P.M.
