

February 6, 2003

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on February 6, 2003 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were Brian Baer, Lamar Glatfelter and Goldie Day. Others present were Timothy Steger, John Kovach, Shirley Simpson, Doris Gracey and Douglas Crawford.

Chairman Brian Baer called the meeting to order with the Pledge. The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was presented to the Board.

There were no public comments.

Lisa Mansperger, tax collector, presented a list of 2002 exonerations on the per capita tax: 36 exonerations for deletions or no longer living in the Township and 193 per capitas to be liened for non-payment. Brian Baer made a motion to exonerate the Tax Collector for the above 229 per capita taxes for the year 2002, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.

Lisa asked that the Township provide her with a letter, stating how much she may charge for tax certifications and also returned checks. York County is asking for this letter. The Board will have Solicitor Herrold prepare a letter for this request.

Douglas Crawford presented the 3-lot subdivision for the Kobi Lynn Johnson property. The Planning Commission signed the plan on January 31<sup>st</sup>. Mr. Crawford wanted to know if some of the lot lines for Lot #1 could be changed to increase the lot size. He was told this could not be changed. Goldie Day made a motion to approve the Johnson plan as presented, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried and the plan was signed.

Doris Gracey was present, asking for a waiver from the Board for land she owns that fronts along Sunny Slope Road. She is short approximately .40 ft. of road frontage. The Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance Section 704, calls for 25 ft. road frontage for a right-of-way. Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to grant a waiver to Doris Gracey for this .40 ft., seconded by Brian Baer. This motion carried.

Tim Steger gave the roadmaster report. Tim thanked the Board for the new truck. Tim was told to put the 1979 International Dump Truck up for sale and to do whatever he wants to do with the old cinder spreaders.

Tim also reported that Ross Paving corrected the driveways today. He hasn't heard from Harmon Builders yet.

The Township will be doing new construction this year on Meckley Road and Pentland Road, using State Liquid Fuels monies.


