

March 6, 2003

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on March 6, 2003 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Brian Baer, Lamar Glatfelter and Goldie Day. There were no others present.

Chairman Baer opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

The treasurer's report was presented to the Board Members.

Since no one was present, there were no public comments.

The Board discussed paying Marlette Thomas a higher hourly rate since he is taking over Roadmaster Tim Steger's responsibilities while Tim is on disability.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to pay Marlette an extra 65 cents per hour retroactive to February 13th, seconded by Brian Baer. This motion carried. This extra pay will only be paid until Tim Steger returns to work.

The Board will open bids for road materials on May 1st.

Road projects for 2003 were discussed. Since township roads will need extensive repairs due to the winter weather conditions, any new construction will be put on hold for the time being. Any roadwork should be by tar and chipping. The Board is looking at tar & chipping Sunny Slope road from S.R. 216 to the top of the hill. This section of the road is already prepared for this type of work.

The Township has received an extension on Graystone, Rosewood and the Waste Water Treatment Plant to April 9, 2003.

The bills were presented to the Board for payment.

Brian Baer made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 P.M.
