The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on December 4, 2003 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were Brian Baer, Lamar Glatfelter and Goldie Day. Others present were Charles Wheat, John Kovach, Marlette Thomas and John Rohrbaugh.

Chairman Baer opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was presented to the Board members.

The bills were presented to the Board for payment. Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian Baer. This motion carried.
