The minutes were approved as written.

George Weisenborn was present with his subdivision plan. Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to sign the plan seconded by Brian Baer. Jason Snyder will have the plan recorded.


Brain Kaltreider gave the Zoning Officer's report. He has issued 3 permits so far for the month of July. Brian Baer said the Cleveland Thompson place is still not cleaned up. Brain Kaltreider will go down and talk to Mr. Thompson.

Brian Baer asked Attorney Herrold if a weed ordinance is needed to make people mow their properties. Attorney Herrold said we can send letters requesting the grass be mowed without an ordinance. There are two properties in the Township one on Shaffers Church Rd. in Neimans and the other on Seven Valleys Rd. with high grass. The Township will send letters to the property owners.

It was reported that a driveway was paved on Doris Blevins property on Snyder Mill Rd. Richard Wells Blacktop Paving did the work. The blacktop and subbase that was removed from her driveway was dumped on the property next door and is clogging the Township pipe. Attorney Herrold will send Mr. Wells a letter to remove this debris.

The bills were presented to the Board. Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to pay the bills seconded by Brian Baer.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
