

November 6, 2003

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on November 6, 2003 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township Building. Board members present were Brian Baer, Lamar Glatfelter and Goldie Day. Others present were Charles Wheat, Randy Sterner, Bill Fogle III, Scott Wehrly, Dave Rehbein & Brittany, Buck Buchanan of the Southern Regional Police Dept. and Liz from the York Dispatch.

Chairman Baer opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as read. The treasurer's report was presented to the Supervisors.

There were no public comments.

Buck Buchanan, Treasurer of the Southern Regional Police Department was present to ask for a donation to help with the D.A.R.E. program in the schools. Funding from the State has been cut back; the Southern Regional Police Dept. would like to continue the program. Since Shrewsbury & Codorus Townships are not members of the police department, both municipalities are being asked to contribute toward this program. The amount of contribution asked for is based on population. The amount of funding needed to continue all classes of the D.A.R.E. Program is \$1,686.83, with Codorus Township contributing \$618.01. (36.64%)

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion that Codorus Township support this program with a contribution on \$618.01, Goldie Day seconded this motion. This motion carried.

William Fogle, III gave the Zoning Officer report for the month. Seven permits were issued.

Scott Wehrly was present. He wishes to add a 48 ft. x 50 ft. addition to the Auction House. Brain Baer made a motion that the Zoning Officer give Scott a building permit for this addition, seconded by Goldie Day. This motion carried.

Bill Fogle also reported that Thomas Gray, Steltz Road is getting a permit for a house and small building.

Randy Sterner, EMC, reported on the Public Safety Day he attended. Discussed were issues affecting workers every day. Society changes are putting demands on fire and rescue services. In 10 years a crisis will be developing which will require changes.

Brian Baer made a motion to advertise the proposed budget as being open for public inspection, seconded by Goldie Day. This motion carried.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to appoint Jerry Lucabaugh to the Zoning Hearing Board to fill the position held by Leland Snyder. Brian Baer seconded this motion. The motion carried. This term will run from November 6, 2003 through December 31, 2006.

A letter from Tracey Bittner was read Mrs. Bittner would like to operate a flea market at her property along S.R. 616. This letter will be turned over to the Township Planning Commission for action.

The Township received the Full Animal Services Agreement from the York County S.P.C.A. The organization is asking for \$620.00 for the annual cost.

Brian Baer made a motion to send \$620.00 to the York County S.P.C.A. for the annual service provided the Township, seconded by Goldie Day. This motion carried.

Township tax collector, Lisa Mansperger, is asking for exoneration for 46 per capita taxes for the Year 2003. These exonerations are for persons that have left the Township, are deceased or for low income.

Goldie Day made a motion to exonerate the tax collector for 46 per capita taxes for the Year 2003, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.

The Board will talk to Solicitor Herrold regarding updating the Township employee policy manual.

The secretary is to ask Marlette to check the driveway at Fireworks property on Greenmount Church Road.

The bills were presented to the Board. Brian Baer made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
