

February 5, 2004

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on February 5, 2004 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt and Goldie Day. Others present were: Randy Sterner, Charles Wheat, Bill Fogle III, Brian Kaltreider and John Kovach.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge. The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was presented to the Board.

Under public comments: Charles Wheat asked how many illegals are working in the Township. He was told this was not known.

The Preston Beall Sewage Planning Module was approved for submission to DEP on motion by Lamar Glatfelter and seconded by Goldie Day. Motion carried.

Randy Sterner reported on the January 17<sup>th</sup> Emergency Management meeting held at the Annex Building, 118 Pleasant Acres Road, York.

From the meeting, Randy learned that PennDot does have a bare roads policy: First the Interstates, second the roads leading into the Interstates and third, local access roads that school buses travel. There are problems with water coming onto State roads and trees leaning on the wires. Schools should alert PennDot when there is an early dismissal. Also, Randy learned that it is illegal to dump or push snow from private driveways onto State Roads.

Emergency management workers should have some advance training. This is a problem since most emergency workers are volunteers and cannot afford to take time for additional training.



He wanted to know if a building permit had been issued to Vincent Lutter for the lot in Jefferson. Donald said if we issue a building permit to Mr. Lutter, the Borough will revoke it. This will have to be looked into.

The bills were submitted to the Board. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.

The Board discussed building permit fees. Irvin said he would like to see the fees raised. He will work on a new fee schedule for a future meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 P.M.
