

December 2, 2004

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on December 2, 2004 in the Township Office. Board members present were Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt, and Goldie Day. Others present were: Tom Moore, Marlette Thomas, and Bill Fogle.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes from the November 10, 2004 meeting were approved.

There were no public comments.

Goldie Day made a motion to appoint Jerry Jones to a new 5 yr. term on the Recreation Board, Ann Corum to a new 3 yr. term on the Zoning Hearing Board, and Cecile Feters to a new 5 yr. term on the Joint Sewer Authority. Lamar Glatfelter seconded the motion the motion carried.

Marlette Thomas gave the roadmaster report. Road work for 2005 was discussed. It was decided to finish the work on Pentland Road. Meckley Rd and Brodbeck's Rd will be paved. Miller and Trump road will be tar & chipped or have wearing placed on it.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. Bill had Mr. MacNamara sign an agreement stating that when he finishing building his new house he needs to make the old house unlivable. The old house cannot be used as a second dwelling. Bill sent a violation notice to Mr. Sprague for the 6 junk cars on his property. Lisa Zartman owner of Boondocks needs to remove the trailer located at the property. A zoning hearing held in 1985 stated that if an addition was put on the building the trailer needed to be moved. Lawrence Davis and Frank Beck are working on cleaning up the junk cars at their properties. Thomas Gray was sent a letter stating that he cannot live in the house he is building on Steltz Rd. because the house does not meet residential dwelling set backs.


Kendra and William Wilson sent a complaint to the Township that there are tires in the woods behind their house. This is the property of Powers Homes. Bill will check out this problem.

Tax Collector, Lisa Mansperger has been charged \$80.00 for checks. Goldie Day made a motion to reimburse Lisa this amount seconded by Irvin Rappoldt. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were submitted to the Board. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to pay the bills seconded by Goldie Day. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:55 P.M.
