

June 9, 2004

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on June 9, 2004 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Members present were Lamar Glatfelter and Irvin Rappoldt. Others present were: April Rehbein, Tom Moore, Deborah Slawson, Bill Fogle, Rick & Teri Sechrist, Erich & Andreas Proepper, John Kovach of the York Dispatch and Jason Snyder of C.S. Davidson.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting to order with the Pledge.

The June 3rd minutes were approved as written.

Erich & Andreas Proepper were present to discuss the tires on their property. The tires were left on the property by Ron Smith. There are approximately 100 tires in the woods. The Proepper's are attempting to get rid of the tires. Lamar said that the Township will work with them.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. No permits have been issued since the last meeting. An enforcement notice will be sent to John Owings, owner of the Cleveland Thompson property on Lineboro Rd. The Thompson's have not finished the construction of the pole building and the property is filling up with junk and cars.

Bill is waiting to get together with Mr. Norris to see where the property lines are on the Thomas Gray property before he contacts Mr. Gray about the work being done at his property.

Attorney Herrold read and reviewed a letter from the American Family Association of PA. No action needs to be taken on this letter.

Tom Moore was present to speak about the upcoming zoning hearing for an extension on the WWTP. Tom and the rest of the Planning Commission have met and discussed their opposition. Tom is asking for support from the Township Supervisors. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion seconded by Lamar Glatfelter to have Attorney Herrold and Jason Snyder represent the Codorus Township Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission at the Zoning Hearing in opposition of the WWTP extension. Attorney Herrold was also asked to be present at a work session to be held before the Zoning Hearing. This motion carried. Tom Moore will let the Township office know the date of the work session.

Jason Snyder stated that work has begun on the access road to the WWTP.

Rick Sechrist was present with the Robin Matthews plan. There were some questions about the right-of-way shown on the plan and the plan had not been signed by the Planning Commission. The plan was not signed at this time.

Irvin made a motion to pay the bills seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. The motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
