

April 7, 2005

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on April 7, 2005 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt, and Goldie Day. Others present were: April Rehbein, Bill Fogle, Marlette Thomas, Randy Sterner, Brittany Rehbein and Cecile Fetters.

The meeting opened with the Pledge to the flag.

The minutes from the last meeting were approved with one correction. The date of the Recreation Board meeting should be March 8, 2005.

Cecile Fetters presented a proposal to the Board from C.S. Davidson for a topographic survey to be done at the park site. The aerial map needs to be done before the leaves are on the trees. This survey will be used by Ann Yost for the park master plan. This survey can also be used in the future for construction documents. Ann said that this type of survey gives the best information and most detail for planning. C. S. Davidson's proposal is for \$6,120.00. The Board asked Cecile to obtain one more quote before they make a decision on this.

Marlette gave the Roadmaster report. We have been receiving complaints about the service from Penn Waste. April will make a list of the complaints and the Board will talk to Attorney Herrold about the complaints. Marlette received a letter from Shrewsbury Township. They would like Codorus to join them in a regional deicing material bid for the winter of 2005-2006. The Supervisors do not want to get involved. The new chipper will probably be ready on April 23, 2005. Marlette has been having problems with stone he is receiving from York Building. He had samples to show the Board. The stone is covered with big clumps of dirt. Lamar said to order the stone from Global stone.

Irvin Rappoldt discussed some changes he would like made to the zoning ordinance. Lamar thought Irvin should present his suggestions to the Planning Commission. Irvin will discuss the changes he would like with Attorney Herrold and the Planning Commission.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. There will be a Zoning Hearing on April 26, 2005 for Lisa Zartman and Ronald Chittum. Bill has been in contact with John Owings about Cleveland Thompson's property. Mr. Owings is working on having the Thompson's clean up the property. Some cars have been hauled away and they will be bringing in a roll off container.


A letter was received from the County Commissioners of York County. Philip Wagner wrote a letter to the Commissioners. Mr. Wagner sent a check to Lisa Mansperger for his 2004 taxes. He received a stamped receipt from Lisa dated March 23, 2004. However the check was never cashed. Mr. Wagner is asking the Township to waive the interest

and penalties that are now due. The Supervisors will allow Mr. Wagner pay the tax bills at the discount rate.

The bills were presented to the Board. Irvin made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Goldie. The motion carried.
