

June 8, 2005

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on June 8, 2005. Board members present were Lamar Glatfelter and Irvin Rappoldt. Others present were Brian Baer, Bill Fogle, Jeff Shue, Attorney John Herrold, Cecile Feters, April Rehbein, and Charles Wehrly.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved. After the minutes were approved Charles Wehrly was officially welcomed to the table to serve as Township Supervisor. Charles will serve the remainder of Goldie Day's term.

The bids were opened and read for the Chipmore Chipper Model TM-80-01 as follows:

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to award the bid to Ron Wolfe the high bidder seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold was contacted by Jim Holley regarding the Gray appeal. A letter was received from Attorney Marc Roberts requesting an extension to the briefing deadline.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to extend the briefing schedule, seconded by Irvin Rappoldt. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

No permits will be issued for the WWTP until everyone is in agreement.

The letters of credit for Hickory Heights are going to expire on August 22, 2005. Attorney Herrold will notify Hickory Heights that the letters need to be extended.

There was discussion on the road right-of-way for Catholic Valley Rd. Attorney Herrold will have one of his staff check on this.

Bill Fogle has been sending enforcement letters to Cleveland Thompson regarding the junk cars. The Thompsons correct the problem by placing the cars in the building, then they bring the cars back out. Attorney Herrold told Bill that if the Thompsons bring the cars back out the violation would be deemed not corrected. If the continuation of the violation is more than 30 days, Bill should take it to the District Justice.
