

July 7, 2005

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on July 7, 2005 at 7:30 P.M. Members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt, and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: April Rehbein, Dave Rehbein, Cecile Feters, Brian Baer, Bill Fogle, and Chris Sellers.

The meeting opened with the Pledge.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to approve the minutes seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Chris Sellers presented the Sewage Facilities Planning Module for a four lot subdivision on Catholic Valley Road. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to adopt and submit to DEP for its approval as a revision to the Official Sewage Facilities Plan of the Municipality the above referenced Sewage Facilities Planning Module, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Sewage Facilities Planning Module for Leo & Sandra Hartlaub for lot 2 only was presented to the Board. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to submit this to DEP, seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

April had a complaint from a Township resident concerning the run-off at 5308 Watertank Road. Every time it rains mud runs onto the Township Road. Bill Fogle will contact Eric Jordan at the York County Conservation District.

April presented pictures to the Board of roofing shingles that were dumped on Sticks School Road and Fair School Road. The shingles were dumped on the Road at approximately 9:00 P.M. on July 3, 2005. A Township resident saw a dump truck but, could not get a tag number.

The side flail on the Tiger Mower is in need of repair. The quote for the parts needed to repair the flail head was \$4,227.30. To replace the flail head would cost \$8,650.00. Since the mower is old and could need further repairs it was decided to purchase a new flail head. Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to make this purchase, seconded by Irvin Rappoldt. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar reported that he and Mr. Heidler have met with the engineers twice at the Brenneman Road Bridge. An agreement has been reached with Mr. Heidler and the paper work was signed and notarized.

Cecile Feters presented a copy of letter which James Holley & Associates sent to DEP. At the June Sewer Authority meeting Jim Holley said they would like to use the Graystone plant for Codorus Estates instead of Rosewood. Also he said they would operate the plant at no more than 95,000 gpd. The Graystone plant would operate as a temporary plant. There was never any bonding for the Graystone plant. Cecile asked if

the Supervisors want to send a letter to DEP requesting bonding be a condition of any permit amendment. Lamar said the Township will ask for a bond before a building permit is issued.

The bills were presented to the Board. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to pay the bills seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 on a motion by Irvin Rappoldt, seconded by Charles Wehrly.
