

May 11, 2005

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on May 11, 2005 at 7:30 P.M. Members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt and Goldie Day. Others present were: April Rehbein, Dave Rehbein, Bill Fogle, Randy Sterner, Hugh Sladden, Jeff Shue and Randy Sterner.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Randy Sterner gave the Emergency Management report. At the last meeting he attended they talked about Americ Corps., an organization that organizes volunteers in the event of an emergency. The Township needs to update the Emergency Management Plan.

Cecile Feters gave the Recreation Board report. Ann Yost was not present at the last Rec. Board meeting because the topographic survey was not received in time. She will be attending the June meeting. The Rec. Board reviewed the Township recreation plan and made revisions. The Board members voted to recommend these revisions to the Board of Supervisors for adoption. Recreation fees for neighboring Townships were checked. The value of lots in the Township have gone up. The Rec Board would recommend to the Board that the rec. fees be raised to \$2,000.00.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to appoint Deborah Slawson to another 4 year term on the Planning Commission seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. The motion carried. Vote 2-1 with Goldie Day opposed.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. He went to check the site distance complaints for Snyder Rd. and S.R. 516. Bill had questions about the clear site triangle in section 604 of the Township Zoning Ordinance. Jeff Shue will get Bill a chart that Penn Dot uses for site distances.

Jeff Shue spoke about the Brenneman Road Bridge bids. Six bids were received. The low bidder was Pflumm Contractors, Inc. with a bid of \$152,310.00. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to award the bid to Pflumm Contractors, Inc. seconded by Goldie Day. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Jeff said the topographic survey of the Rockville Road recreation area has been completed. It will be forwarded to Ann Yost.

Resolution No. 2005-2, approving the sewage facilities plan adopted by Jefferson Borough was presented. Goldie Day made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2005-2 seconded by Irvin Rappoldt. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Charles Wehrly gave the report of the York Earned Income meeting. Adams County would like to merge with the York County Earned Income Tax Bureau. The Township

will need to adopt a resolution agreeing to have Adams & York County Tax Bureau's combined.


Goldie Day read her resignation. She is resigning from Township Supervisor as May 12, 2005. Goldie is moving out of the Township and will no longer be able to hold this position.

The bills were presented to the Board.

Goldie Day made a motion to pay the bills seconded by Irvin Rappoldt. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 P.M. seconded by Lamar Glatfelter.
