

June 2, 2005

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on June 2, 2005 at 7:30 P.M. Members present were: Lamar Glatfelter and Irvin Rappoldt. Others present were: Brian Baer, Mr. & Mrs. Lewis Williams, Bill Fogle, Cecile Fetters, Marlette Thomas, Virginia Parker and April Rehbein.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to approve the minutes seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Michael Bittner of 2993 Seven Valleys Rd. would like to set off fireworks on September 17, 2005. He presented his license and state permit to the Board. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to allow Mr. Bittner to set off fireworks on September 17, 2005 seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Lewis Williams of 4031 Hilltop Ln. was present with a complaint of soil erosion. Mr. Williams stated that water is running from Virginia Parker's farm down to his place causing ruts and erosion. The water is also running down into the creek and their pond. Lamar suggested contacting Eric Jordan at the York County Conservation District.

Virginia Parker was present with her subdivision plan. Lamar made a motion to approve this plan seconded by Irvin Rappoldt. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Marlette Thomas gave the Roadmaster report. Marlette reported that the pipe work on Meckley Rd. is finished. There is still some work that needs to be done on Miller Rd. Marlette followed up on a complaint from a resident on Catholic Valley Rd. Robert Morris, 3153 Catholic Valley Road has a harrow sitting at the edge of his property to keep vehicles off his grass. Mr. Morris would like the Township to define right-a-way.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. He received a complaint from two neighbors on Seven Valleys Rd. The owners have had the properties surveyed and found that the driveway is 60 ft. over the property line and there are a couple of buildings that will not meet the setbacks. The Supervisors will let the Attorney's of the property owners handle this matter.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to update the Codorus Township Recreation Plan as submitted by the Recreation Board. Irvin seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Bill Deal investigated two sewage complaints. One for William Mintscheff and the other one was for Steven Mintscheff. The Board will contact Bill Deal for the lab results on these two properties.

The bills were presented to the Board. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to pay the bills seconded by Lamar Glatfelter.

Lamar Glatfelter met with Steve Malesker of C.S. Davidson and Terry Heidler at the Brenneman Road Bridge. Mr. Heidler did not approve of the bridge plans as presented. Jeff Shue and Lamar Glatfelter will meet with Mr. Heidler at a later date.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to appoint Charles Wehrly to serve the remainder of Goldie Day's term as Township Supervisor. Irvin Rappoldt seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:35 P.M. seconded by Lamar Glatfelter.
