The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on August 4, 2005 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township building. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: April Rehbein, Sandra Hartlaub, Brian Baer, Dawn Wild-Austin, Cecile Feters, Jerry Jones, Bill Fogle, David Ponita and Tim Miller

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to approve the minutes as presented seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Jerry Jones spoke to the Board about the erosion problem at Johnson Road. Jerry asked if there is a better way to handle the run off problem. Jerry thought that grass could be planted and large stones could be put in the ditch. Lamar said that this road will be looked at in the spring of 2006. Pipes need to be put in to carry the down to the stream.

Sandra Hartlaub was present with the subdivision plan for her property on Snyder Road. She was told her plan needs to go back to the Planning Commission before presenting it to the Supervisors.

Tim Miller of Aflac gave a presentation to the Board. The Board will show the brochures to the Township workers.

Dawn Wild-Austin owns a property on Buffalo Valley Rd. The former property owner told her the property would not perc. She would like to put a holding tank on this property. Lamar told her our ordinance will not allow holding tanks. Lamar recommended she call Bill Deal and have a perc test done.

Bill Fogle was told to check on the Holewinski property on Buffalo Valley Rd. there is at least 2 junk cars and could be more hidden in the weeds.

The Glen Rock Church of Christ sent a written request to combine the two parcels owned by the church. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to combine the two parcels, seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:55 P.M. seconded by Lamar Glatfelter.
