The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on December 1, 2005. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: April Rehbein, Robert Gladfelter, Dave Rehbein, Bill Fogle, Sharon Lambert and Sue Gordon from the York Area Agency on Aging.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to approve the minutes as written, seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Sue Gordon of the York County Area Agency on Aging was present. Sue gave a power point presentation on the International property maintenance code. The code if adopted would give the Township the right to enter and the right to enforce poor living conditions. This would ensure public health, safety and welfare. The Supervisors will look over the book that Ms. Gordon has presented to the Board.

Sharon Lambert spoke to the Board about public awareness. She would like to see the Township establish a web site or newsletter.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. Cleveland Thompson of Lineboro Rd. has been evicted and the property is getting cleaned up. The pole building will be removed.

Lisa Zartman called Bill about the right-of-way that runs up to her property. Donald Steger spoke to Lisa and told her she cannot use the right-of-way. The Board said that the right of way has existed for years.

Lamar Glatfelter talked about a new heating system for the shop area. Shipley is giving an estimate on a radiant heating system which should save about 30% on heating cost. Lamar will also contact Davidson for an estimate.

The bills were presented to the Board. Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 P.M. on a motion by Irvin, seconded by Lamar.
