The Township only enforces that the driveway is kept up to the specs in the driveway agreement.

Mike Schmidt had questions about the Erich Proepper property. Mike stated that a septic system was installed at this property on March 13, 2003. A permit was obtained from Bill Deal for a septic repair. Bill Fogle will speak to Bill Deal about this problem.

Bill Fogle reported that James Bailey is tearing down an old chicken house and would like to put up a new building using the same footer. Bill ask the Board if Jim needs a new land development plan. Bill was told that since the building is being replaced on the same footer with the same dimensions a new land development plan is not required.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 P.M. seconded by Lamar Glatfelter.
