

April 12, 2006

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on April 12, 2006 in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt and Robert Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Cecile Feters, Randy Sterner, Lisa Zartman, Wayne McSherry, Rod Hurley, Donald & Vicki Steger, Jeff Shue and Attorney John Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Irvin made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Rod Hurley a resident of Johnson Road was present. He asked the Board if the logging operation William Holcomb's property is legal. Mr. Holcomb owns a tree service in Maryland and he brings the logs up to his property to cut up and chip the wood. Mr. Hurley was told that logging is permitted in the Ag zone of the Township. The Board will have a look at the property to make sure that everything is being handled properly.

Carl Mainolfi of 3204 Sticks Road had some concerns with the dirt portion of Mummert Road off of Sticks Road. The back of his house faces Mummert Road. There is only one house located on this portion of the road. The road is being used by big trucks and other vehicles as a cross road. There is also dumping going on. Mr. Mainolfi ask if signs could be put up or the road closed at the Sticks end. The Board will look at this road and try to come up with some solution.

Lisa Zartman and Wayne McSherry were back before the Board with the problem of the right-of-way off of Glenville road. Lisa was told that this is a private matter between Lisa and the Mr. & Mrs. Steger.

Randy Sterner gave the report on the April Emergency Management meeting. Randy is still working on the Nims training which we need to have before September 30, 2006.

The Board had some questions for Attorney Herrold about hiring someone to replace Marlette. Two existing employees were interviewed for Marlette's position. The Board can hire one of them. Attorney Herrold said that the other position does not need to be advertised but, he would suggest that the Board run an ad...

Jeff Shue spoke to the Board about the culvert on Shaffers Church Road that needs replaced. A proposal was received from Aquatic Resource Restoration Company. This company can design permit and construct the culvert.

Cecile Feters gave the Recreation Board report. Ann Yost of YSM was present at the Rec. Board meeting last night. Ann will be sending a proposal for the baseball field and limited construction.


