

May 4, 2006

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on May 4, 2006 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt and Bob Gladfelter. Other present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Brittany Rehbein, Rene Debrabander, Bill Fogle and Mr. & Mrs. Charles Wheat.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Irvin Rappoldt made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Under public comment Charles Wheat asked how many illegal immigrants are in the Township. He was told we do not keep records on immigrants.

Bob made a motion to award the bid to the low bidder York Building Products. Irvin seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bids for placing Superpave binder & Superpave wearing were opened and read as follows:

Stewart & Tate bid:

1800 tons superpave asphalt mixture 19.0 mm binder course @ \$5.249 per ton for a total of \$9,448.20

1250 tons superpave asphalt mixture 9.5 mm wearing course @ \$5.249 per ton for a total of \$6,561.25

Kinsley Construction bid:

1800 tons superpave asphalt mixture 19.0 mm binder course @ \$8.35 per ton for a total of \$15,030.00

1250 tons superpave asphalt mixture 9.5 mm wearing course @ \$8.35 per ton for a total of \$10,437.50

Longs Asphalt bid:

1800 tons superpave asphalt mixture 19.0 mm binder course @ \$6.35 per ton for a total of \$11,430.00

1250 tons superpave asphalt mixture 9.5 mm wearing course @ \$6.35 per ton for a total of \$7,937.50

Lamar made a motion to award the bid to the low bidder Stewart & Tate. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bids for E-3 Emulsion were opened and read as follows:

Stewart & Tate bid:

40,000 gals E-3 Emulsion @ \$1.59 per gal. for a total of \$63,600.00

Hammaker East bid:

40,000 gals E-3 Emulsion @ 1.449 per gal. for a total of \$57,960.00

Bob made a motion to award the bid to the low bidder Hammaker East, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

One bid was received for 7,000 gals of diesel fuel and 2,000 gals of heating oil from Shipley Energy Co. Since an escalator clause was included in the bid the Supervisors rejected the bid.

Mark Krebs would like a waiver for his property off Hildebrand Rd. The right-of-way should be 25ft. and he would like a waiver to have it 20 ft. Lamar the motion to grant the waiver to Mark Krebs, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Sewage Planning Module for phase 2 of the Powers Homes plan was presented to the Board. Irvin made the motion, seconded by Bob to send the module to DEP. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Sewage Planning Module for Dale Folkenroth was presented to the Board. Bill Deal's signature was missing and there was no check enclosed. Lamar made a motion to have April sign the plan and submit to DEP upon receiving the check and Bill Deal's signature. Irvin seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

John Owing's presented his add on Subdivision plan for his property located on Lineboro Rd. Irvin made a motion to approve the final plan, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

William & Debra McGrew's final subdivision plan was presented to the Board for approval. Irvin made the motion to approve and sign the plan, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Three quotes were received for 6,000 gals of calcium chloride. They were read as follows:


1. JMG Enterprises, Inc. quoted 0.8000 per gallon

Bob made a motion to accept the quote of JMG Enterprises, Inc. Irvin seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. James Holley would like to obtain a building permit to complete the WWTP, build the control building and bring in the office trailer. The Board told Bill that he can issue the permit.

The bills were presented to the Board. Irvin made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:25 on a motion by Irvin, seconded by Bob.
