The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on August 3, 2006 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township Office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: Laverne Wolfgang, April Rehbein, Dave Rehbein, Betty Lou Smith, Randy Sterner, Doug Crawford and Mr. & Mrs. Chris Miller.

The meeting opened with the Pledge to the flag.

Lamar made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Doug Crawford presented the Georgia Bathon final subdivision plan for approval. Bob made a motion to approve the plan. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Chris Miller the president of the Bowling Green Speedway club was present. Chris asked if signs could be erected on the approach to the Bowling Green Memorial Stone stating that the memorial is ahead. Chris would also like to put in a couple of parking spots. Chris should get permission from Chilcoat and Peters for the parking spots. If he purchases the signs the Township road crew can put them up.

Randy Sterner gave the report from the quarterly Emergency Management meeting. Randy would like to see the staff that is on the Township Emergency Management plan trained.

The Powers Homes planning sewage planning module was resubmitted to the Board of Supervisors with a change to the narrative. Lamar made a motion to resubmit the module to DEP seconded by Irvin.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the roadmaster report. Tar and chipping will begin on August 14th. The culvert pipe at Johnson & Myers Road. The propane tank has been installed. Laverne discussed the problem with the pipe at the Vance property on Hawk Hill Road. This problem was discussed before and no action has been taken by Mr. Vance. Laverne and Bill will meet with Mr. Vance on August 8th at 7:30 A.M.

A complaint was received that an electric cord is running across Wool Mill Road at Patricia Rush's property. There is a camper parked across from her house and the electric cord is running across the road to the camper. Bill will contact the property owner about this complaint.

Bill Fogle gave his report. Samuel Schofield of 4311 Shaffers Church Rd. said that he did not receive the enforcement notice that Bill left at his property. Bill will send Mr. Schofield a certified letter.

Bill is sending an enforcement letter to Michael Dotson because the house he owns at the corner of Wool Mill Road and Blooming Grove Road is not secure.

The ATV ordinance was discussed. Bill presented the Board with a list of complaints. Lamar stated that if the ordinance is passed when complaints are received the Township will send Bill out to show the offender a copy of the ordinance and to explain the ordinance to them. All complaints will be reviewed at a Supervisors meeting before any charges are filed with the District Magistrate.

The propane agreement from Shipley was presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to sign the agreement seconded by Irvin. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Irvin made a motion to pay the bill seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M. on a motion made by Bob and seconded by Lamar.
