The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on September 7, 2006 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Irvin Rappoldt and Robert Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Dave Rehbein, Brian Baer, Bill Fogle, Pat Isch, Steven Isch, Laverne Wolfgang and Betty Lou Smith.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Irvin made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The sewage planning module for John & Denise Inch was presented to the Board. Irvin made a motion to approve and sign the module, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the roadmaster report. Most of the past month was spent patching roads. Nafe Sawmill Rd. & Watertank Rd. were completely tar & chipped. John has been grading dirt roads. The propane tank has been installed and is filled with propane. Paving work should begin on Brodbeck Road on Sept 14th & 15th. Laverne spoke to the Board about an air brake seminar. Someone from the Township should be certified to work on brakes. Bob made a motion to send John Rohrbaugh to two air brake seminars, Irvin seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.


Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. Thomas Grey was taken to the magistrate. The magistrate fined Mr. Grey \$500.00 plus court cost. Mr. Grey has 30 days to appeal the magistrate's decision. After 30 days with no appeal Mr. Grey will be in violation every day that he resides at the property. Lawrence Davis asked the Magistrate for a continuance. He would like to have a Zoning Hearing for a junk yard. Bill will be sending a letter to Elfriede Young. The person who is living at her property on Birthday Club Road is parking a vehicle on the road blocking the use for farm equipment and the Township grader. Bill is also sending a letter to John Harman of Ridge Road. It has been reported to the Township that Mr. Harman has an illegal apartment in his basement. It has also been reported to the Township that someone is living in the house at David & Helen Tuten's property. This house was supposed to be converted into a business when the new house was built. Bill will look into this.

Bob Gladfelter discussed the health insurance renewal with the Board.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Irvin. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 P.M. and the Board went into executive session.
