The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on March 11, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Jeff Homes, Attorney John Herrold and Bill Fogle.

The meeting opened with the Pledge.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold issued a judgment against Michelle Long for the fine that she owes the Township.

The Board discussed the Road agreement between the Duncan's and the Selig's was discussed. According to the agreement all disputes would be handled by the York County Court of Common Pleas instead of having the Township Roadmaster settling disputes. Attorney Herrold will contact Dr. Duncan and have him remove the Township from the agreement. After the agreement is signed and notarized it will be returned to Attorney Herrold to record.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. Earl Grey of Shaffers Church Road is still working on the driveway without a permit.

Bill has contacted Janet Hoffler and Mark Seelig about naming the private drive off of Fair School Rd.

Lamar made a motion to appoint William Lear to another term on the Recreation Board, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Billy Gilbert of Buffalo Valley Road has complained to the Township concerning trash blowing on to his property from the Codorus Estates development. Lamar met with Greg from Ryan Homes and most of the trash is blowing out the residents recycling bins.

A addendum to the contract with YSM for the construction drawings for the municipal park was presented. Bob made a motion to sign the addendum, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:14 P.M.
