The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on September 3, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Bill Fogle, Bettylou Smith, Steve Hoff, Jennie Hall, Mike Bittner and Sonny Bullaj.

The meeting opened with the Pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bids were opened and read for the storm related damage repair and bank restoration for a section of Shaffers Church Road and a section of Buffalo Valley Road as follows:

JAM Superior Excavating bid \$54,263.52

York County Paving bid \$37,000

Kinsley Construction bid \$23,900

Aquatic Resource Restoration bid \$14,837.17

Brian made a motion to award the bid to the low bidder Aquatic Resource Restoration. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Mike Bittner requested a fireworks permit for September 5, 2009 at 8:00 P.M. All of his credentials were still on file at the Township. Bob made a motion to sign the permit. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Steve Hoff and Jennie Hale were before the board regarding a pre fab horse barn they had placed in their yard. Bill Fogle said they did not obtain a permit and the barn was placed in the front setbacks. They were told to obtain a permit and move the barn within the setbacks.

Sonny Bullaj presented a sketch of his property to the Board. He wanted to see where he should have the perc done for his proposed subdivision.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the Roadmaster report. The pickup was in for repair due to a recall. The Road crew have been working on repairs due to the rain damage. Laverne reported that the bridge on Sunny Slope Road that is jointly owned with Shrewsbury Township is starting to undermine.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. Bill has an application for a driveway permit on Reservoir Road. This driveway does not meet the sight distance requirements. The Board will issue a waiver.

The Board discussed Health Insurance. April will call some other Township to see what insurance carriers they are using.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:25 P.M.
