The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on December 3, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Bill Fogle, Randy Sterner and Bettylou Smith.

The meeting opened with the Pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Randy Sterner gave the Emergency Management report. There is a new form for damage assessment. Randy is still working on the comfort stations.

Lamar made a motion to appoint Jerry Jones to a new 5 year term on the Recreation Board. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Brian made a motion to appoint Jerry Lucabaugh to a new 3 year term on the Zoning Hearing Board. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob made motion to appoint Cecile Feters to a new 5 year term on the Jefferson Codorus Joint Sewer Authority. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the Roadmaster report. The work on the Mummert Road cul-de-sac has been completed until spring. Aquatic Resources has completed the road work on Buffalo Valley Road. The paper work has been completed for the Ridge and Young Road projects. Vandals drove cars across the field at the new ballpark. A report was filed with the State Police. The roadcrew put up a temporary wire and post fence.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. Bill reported that the Zoning Hearing Board ruled in favor of William Davis. The Zoning Hearing Board will be holding a decision meeting for the cell tower on January 5th at 6:30 P.M.

The Board discussed the work that needs to be done at the Township Park. The Board decided to put the work out for bid.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
