The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on February 5, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter, and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Bettylou Smith and Bill Fogle.

The meeting opened with the Pledge to the flag.

The minutes from the Organization were corrected as follows the last paragraph of page two should read that Lamar made the second. The minutes were approved as corrected.

Under public comments Bettylou Smith commented on the ice at the corner of Shaffers Church Road and Seven Valleys Road. Laverne said the work will be completed this spring to try and eliminate the water runoff problem.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the Roadmaster report. The water pump at the Township building is not working. Ray Masimore will be in tomorrow. The emergency lights have been installed. The security system has been installed but, is not working properly.

Bill gave the Zoning Officer report. Bill will be sending letters out to people that have not called for their final inspections. Bill reported that the Zoning Hearing Board granted a variance for the cell tower at the Gantz property. A variance was granted for a temporary road going through the AG zone and a variance was granted for the tower not going on a wooded lot.

The Board discussed raising the Tax Collectors Compensation to 5% for all taxes collected. Brian will contact Attorney Herrold regarding a resolution. The Tax Collector would like to start using software for tax collecting. The software cost \$800.00 per year. The Board agreed to purchase the software.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
