The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on March 5, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider, and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: Laverne Wolfgang, April Rehbein, Bettylou Smith, Bob Rebert, Robert Rebert, Bonnie Holmes and Pete Kelly.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Robert Rebert was present with questions and concerns with regards to his property being in Ag Security in Codorus Township. Lamar explained to Mr. Rebert that Codorus Township does not have a proposal to add his land to Ag Security. Lamar explained that the Ag Security Law (Act 43 of 1981) states the proposal shall be submitted to all governing bodies affected.

Bonnie Holmes was present regarding her proposed subdivision. The Board has visited the site and feels that the driveway should be off of Foxtail Ln. for safety purposes. Mrs. Holmes has approached the Bedgars regarding this but; the Bedgars do not want the driveway off of their lane. The Board would like to meet with the Bedgars.

Dan Rodgers Sewage Planning Module was presented to the Board. Brian made a motion to sign the module and submit to DEP. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the Roadmaster report. The water pump on the mower tractor needs to be rebuilt at a cost of approximately \$700.00 - \$800.00. The tires on the pickup will need to be replaced soon. The men will be starting pipe work on Schuman Road.

April presented a map that was dropped off at the Township by Mike Jacoby. The map was printed off of Enviromapper for Envirofacts web site. This map show Gettysburg College located on Seven Valleys Road in Larue.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:50 P. M. The Board went into executive session.
