

April 8, 2009

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on April 8, 2009 at 7:30 P. M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Attorney John Herrold, Bill Fogle and a large group of Township residents.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brain made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Robert Rebert III approached the Board regarding the sewage lines running under the AG zone. Mr. Rebert stated that Zoning Ordinance does not allow this. Lamar stated that a decision was made at the Zoning Hearing hearing that was held for the treatment plant. Mr. Rebert does not feel that the hearing for the treatment plant included the lines that were proposed through the AG zone. Attorney Herrold will investigate this matter.

The bids were opened for the placing of 975 tons of superpave asphalt mixture 19.0 mm binder course .3-3 million ESAL and 730 tons of superpave asphalt mixture 9.5 mm wearing course .3-3 million ESAL. The bids were opened and read as follows.

Stewart & Tate bid:

\$7.63 per ton for superpave binder, for a total of \$7,439.25  
\$7.63 per ton for superpave wearing, for a total of \$5,569.90  
Total Bid was \$13,009.15

Longs Asphalt bid:

\$8.15 per ton for superpave binder, for a total of \$7,946.25  
\$ 8.15 per ton for superpave wearing, for a total of \$5,949.50  
Total Bid was \$13,895.75

Kinsley Construction bid:

\$7.92 per ton for superpave binder, for a total of \$7,722.00  
\$8.59 per ton for superpave wearing, for a total of \$6,270.70  
Total Bid was \$17,203.45

Emory Peters bid:

\$10.09 per ton for superpave binder, for a total of \$9,837.75  
\$10.09 per ton for superpave wearing, for a total of \$7,365.70  
Total Bid was \$17,203.45

Shiloh Paving bid:

\$6.46 per ton for superpave binder, for a total of \$6,298.50  
\$10.80 per ton for superpave wearing, for a total of \$7,884.00  
Total Bid was \$14,182.50

H & H bid:

\$8.34 per ton for superpave binder, for a total of \$8,131.50  
\$8.34 pr ton for superpave wearing, for a total of \$6,088.20  
Total Bid was \$6,088.20

Lamar made a motion to award the bid to Stewart and Tate the low bidder. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold presented Ordinance #09-01 which prohibits livestock on lots smaller than 1.5 acres. Bob made the motion to adopt ordinance #09-01, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold presented Ordinance #09-02 repealing the per capita tax ordinance adopted by the Township on March 4, 1955. Brian made a motion to adopt ordinance #09-02, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Cecile Fetters gave the Recreation Board report. The Board is applying for a grant through DCNR. Bob made a motion to adopt the resolution for the DCNR grant application. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:25 P.M.
