The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on May 7, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Bonnie & Jeff Homes, Doug Crawford, Bettylou Smith and Doug Crawford.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Lamar Glatfelter announced that a duly published meeting of the Codorus Township Board of Supervisors, the Jefferson Borough Council and the Jefferson Codorus Joint Sewer Authority was held on April 22, 2009 at 7:00 P.M.

Typographical corrections were made to the minutes. Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Sergeant Jeffrey Barbour of the York County Sherriff office was present with Deputy Rupp. He spoke to Board about the Criminal Response Unit. This purpose of the program is to create opportunities for the inmates to give back to the community. The work crews are all low grade offenders. They would be accompanied by 3 armed deputies at all times. The work crew can work on community projects such as trash removal, landscaping and painting. The Board will look over the paper work and contact Sergeant Barbour.

Doug Crawford presented the sewage planning module for Brian Baer. Bob made a motion to submit the module DEP. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Doug also presented the sewage planning module for Wendy Nuri. Lamar made a motion to submit the module to DEP. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Earl Gray sewage planning module was presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to submit the module to DEP. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bonnie and Jeff Homes appeared before the Board regarding the driveway for their proposed subdivision. The Homes have not been able to reach an agreement with the Bedgars regarding a right of way. The Board would like the driveway to be off of Foxtail Ln. but if an agreement cannot be reached with the Bedgars another location will be looked at.

Resolution 09-04 was presented to the Board. This resolution appoints Charles Wehrly as a voting delegate for the York Earned Income and Marsha McKnight as an alternate. Bob made the motion to adopt Resolution 09-04, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report.

The bills were presented to the Board.

Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 P.M.
