The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on September 9, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Bill Fogle, Attorney John Herrold and Sheila Beichner of Penn Waste.

The meeting opened with the Pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Sheila Beichner handles the civil complaints for Penn Waste. Sheila presented the Board with some changes that Penn Waste would like the Township to make an amendment to Ordinance 97-1. The changes would allow Penn Waste to collect late fees and legal fees from customers that have past due bills. At this time there is \$7,796.02 past due over 120 days from Codorus Township customers. Attorney Herrold and the Board will review the changes and make a decision at the October 14, 2009 meeting.

Attorney Herrold gave an update on some old issues he is still working on.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
