The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on November 11, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney John Herrold, Jeff Shue, Bettylou Smith, Earl Gray, Robert Adams, Dennis Thompson, Keith Kreisel and Josh George.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Dennis Thompson the newly elected Constable would like a letter from the Township giving him permission to obtain municipal plates for his vehicle. The vehicle will be registered under the office of Constable Codorus Township. Attorney Herrold will look into this and get back to Dennis with an answer.

Lamar made a motion that the Board will provide the letter after receiving the okay from Attorney Herrold. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Earl Gray and Robert Adams presented the final subdivision plan for the Gray property along with the road maintenance agreement. Jeff Shue said the final inspection of the driveway has not been completed. Bob made a motion to approve the plan subject to the stormwater inspection. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0. The plan will be held in the Township office until the final inspection is completed. Brian made a motion to sign the road maintenance agreement, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Keith Kreisel of Braintune Studio spoke to the Board about a website design. The design and the programming would cost approximately \$1500.00 - \$2000.00. The cost of hosting the site would be approximately \$100 per year. The Board would like to think about it.

Josh George presented the final subdivision plan for the WWTP lot. Bob made a motion to approve the plan, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Josh George presented the preliminary subdivision plan for the Hills at Valley View development. The planning commission has approved the waivers for this plan. Lamar made a motion to approve the preliminary plan as well as the waivers. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The agreement between Codorus Township and HTI for use of equipment at the Township Recreation area was presented. Bob made a motion to have the Lamar sign the agreement, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
