The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on December 10, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Bill Fogle, Rob Wood and Attorney Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as written.

Rob Wood was present regarding an enforcement letter he received from Bill Fogle. Rob was told he needs to obtain amusement permits for the fairy festival and the Harvest festival at least 60 days before the event. Rob also said that he is a non-profit organization. The Board asked to provide proof that has a non-profit organization. Lamar made a motion to lower the fine from \$900.00 to \$300.00. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold went over the resolution for Penn Waste. He will draft a resolution for the next meeting.

The Board reviewed the final budget for approval. Lamar made a motion to adopt the 2010 budget, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar made a motion to authorize \$14,280.64 be transferred from the General Fund to the State Liquid Fuels fund due to a Penn Dot Audit. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
