Curt McCullian discussed the solar ordinance and how it puts restrictions on homeowners wanting to install it for their personal use.

Jen CruverKibi reviewed the DCED audit for Codorus Township. The audit received an unmodified ranking. She also discussed the management letter provided on internal control.

Jason made a motion to send the solar ordinance to the planning commission for review. Brandon seconded. Motion approved.

Brandon made a motion to reject and readvertise for the building repair. Jason seconded. Motion carried

Brandon discussed updating the employee handbook

Brandon made a motion to ratify hiring Zach Weaver for the road crew. Charlie seconded. Motion carried

Brandon let the public know about upcoming road closures.
